The Mover

responsibilities

- > Do the heavy lifting,
- > Move appliances to the truck
- > Transport to new location
- > Place appliances in new home

The Homeowner

responsibilities

- CLEAN all appliances
- PREP all appliances
- OPTIONS
- A. Owner takes care of,
 - B. Hire a technician, or
 - C. Hire the mover to make the arrangements

Servicing Defined

Preparing an appliance to safely withstand handling during moving or while in storage. This can include bracing, disconnecting, capping-off, and special handling of components.

Mover Does Not

- } Disconnect or reconnect appliances
- } Disconnect utilities
- } Repair appliances
- } Remove or install window air conditioners, TV's or antennas
- } Do wiring, plumbing, electrical, or carpentry services

Who does What

- TECHNICIAN prepares appliance for moving
- GAS COMPANY disconnects/caps gas
- MOVER moves appliances
- OWNER sets-up "servicing-arrangements" at old and new home - or hires Mover to do it
